Promoting Good Practices in VET Mobility for Disabled Learners

THE PROJECT

MAKE IT HAPPEN is a transnational project designed to develop and share **best practices** and promote **cooperation** amongst **VET providers in Europe** with a specific focus on facilitating the access to Education and Vocational Training Mobility for disabled learners. The project is co-financed by the European Commission under the **Erasmus Plus programme**. It was launched in Bordeaux in February 2020 and will close in Lisbon in June 2022. Along its 30-month international path, it will encompass 5 Transnational Meetings that will allow the partner organisations to exchange experiences and practices on the project's main concerns, to gather them into a catalogue of best practices, to draft an up-to-date State of the Art and to **enhance the inclusion of disabled learners in mobility opportunities** across Europe.

EXPECTED IMPACT AND RESULTS

Firstly, we want to **improve staff skills and knowledge** about the inclusion policies of each country involved in the project and encourage all partners to collect best practices from virtuous organisations in the field of education or training for SEN learners. Secondly, we want to **create a European Network** of economical actors interested in opening their doors to disabled learners, social actors and educational institutions including VET providers aiming at promoting training mobility opportunities for disabled learners. Thirdly, as a result of our mutual cooperation, we aim at drafting **a European State of the Art** presenting each partners' local context from a social, economic, cultural and legal perspective on the inclusion of disabled people in education and in the labour market, and **a Catalogue of Best Practices** coming up from the transnational meetings.



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
